If we purchase the truck, it would require an increase of \$7500 for each municipality over what we are currently paying for a total of \$14,500 yearly for ten years. Each municipality needs to approve this at their October meetings. The firemen will not be holding their dance this year because of Covid 10 concerns but they will still be sending out donation letters.

Road Update: Road ditches are being cleaned. And we need to look into new rear tires for the end loader.

The county approved the notice of appeal for Joe Clement with the condition the building be attached to the house. Joe presented to the board the revised site plan showing the connection between the building and the house. A motion was made and seconded to concur with the county recommendations. The motion carried.

There is a Coon Creek Watershed Planning Meeting on September 17 at 10 am and 6:30 pm at the Coon Valley American Legion.

We reviewed the miscellaneous correspondence. We received a copy of Terry Dickman's building permit. Ryan Clements shared his plan for building a house. The board has no objections and advised to proceed to the county and use the family connection. Ron Chamberlain will be at our October meeting with planning details on the reconstruction on County H. Our next meeting will be Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at 6:00 pm. A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
