



## **Debbie Jacobs Seminar: Fundamentals of Behavior for Dog Trainers**

The content in this presentation is based on the scientific study of animal behavior and how dogs learn, along with the experience and teaching of well-known trainers. This info is the foundation for further learning about working with fearful dogs. The seminar is suitable for all levels of trainers, dog owners who would like more in-depth knowledge of behavior, as well as vet staff and shelter staff.

**Topics will include:** Everything you need to know about behavior but didn't know who to ask. Why dogs do what they do, and how to humanely and efficiently train them. How the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis can help in the understanding of dog training. Much of the content will apply to all dogs, but some will be specific to fearful dogs. There will be plenty of time for questions and discussion of topics of interest to the group.
