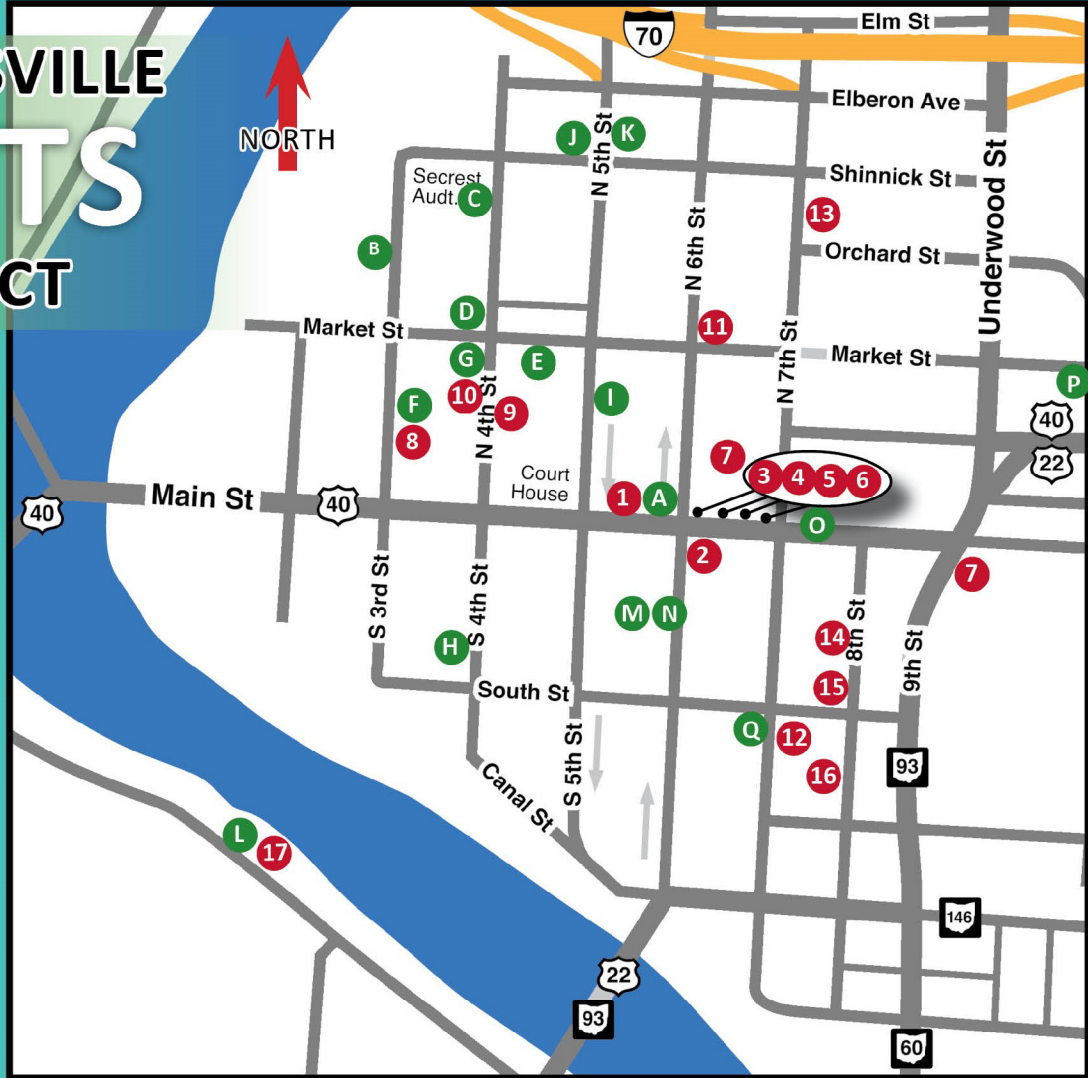

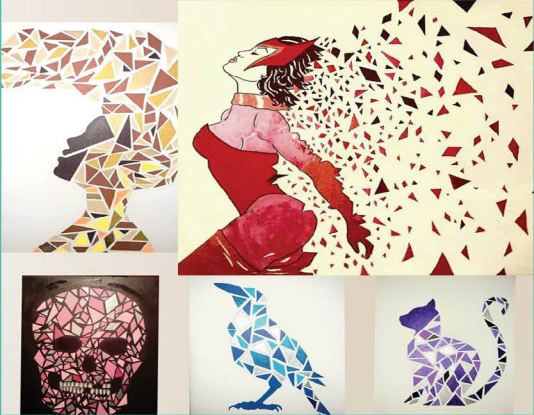
Musician of the month



Bill Stoneburner

I am basically self-taught and my music is sincere, and true from the heart. At a young age, I remember listening to albums and 45's on a suitcase type turntable with built-in speakers. I would listen to about anything available. At about 7th grade, I started piano lessons and enjoyed playing songs like Sound of Music, Moon River, Alley Cat, and Alfie from sheet music. Later in years an album came out by Neil Young entitled "Harvest." I quickly fell in love with the acoustic sounds and then began my desire to play guitar. Not having the luxury of the Internet, I was always on the lookout for song books and sheet music by Neil. Most had the guitar "symbols" above the piano notes and so began my self-learning. I always played by myself until later years at which time I began playing mainly classic rock at restaurants, festivals, fundraisers, neighborhood parties, open mics and art galleries. Artist of the Month



Brayden Heath

The Boho Raven is what Local Artist Brayden Heath decided to name his Art Business in mid 2020. The name "Boho" derives from its definition of being unconventional. The definition of unconventional means to not conform to what is generally done or believed and with that ideal term and Brayden Heath's love for Ravens the name stuck around. As a Zanesville native and artist Brayden Heath has been a part of ARTCOZ off and on for the past 10 years often attending first Friday art walks as well as several events and meetings. When the 2020 pandemic struck the world which shut down the art community completely Brayden knew he had to keep his spark of creativity (and sanity) alive and so in May of 2020 The Boho Raven was born. Specializing in custom and original acrylic paintings Brayden's style of art could be known to him as "Geometric Modernism" . A process using silhouettes and different shapes and shades of color give the painting a unique, vibrant look that's both loud and subtle. "The process is unorthodox, I have always loved more modern styles of artwork I found my style several months ago when I was asked to do a live painting session and honestly I had no clue what I'd make and I think that by just diving in with no plan it sometimes can lead to the best outcomes and fortunately that time it did."

Brayden Heath gives some advice for those who are possibly too shy to come forward with their artistic abilities.

"Some have asked me why it took so long to start a business or even come forward with my art after being in the art community for the last decade and I tell them the truth. As an artist we can doubt ourselves and unfortunately we doubt ourselves alot. I was no exception, we compare ourselves to others and we seek validation from everyone. It could be for our art or for how we identify ourselves. I think when I realized I am not getting any younger and that my happiness mattered more to me than the judgment of others then things began to open up for me. If you want to show the world who you are but are afraid of their opinions I think you should do it anyway because people will share their opinions regardless of having your approval. Everyone has potential, Everyone is someone, Everyone can achieve great things regardless of what the haters believe. My only regret is that I didn't fight for my happiness and my art sooner but I truly believe I'm just getting started."

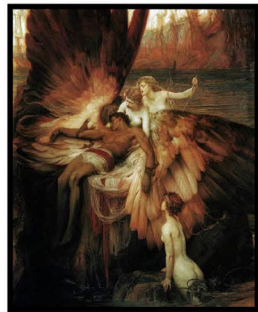
