Doing advance preparation will force thinking about options and selecting what will suit you and your family best. It is natural to be reluctant to do advance preparation but it is important to remember that death can occur any time and in some cases, is very un-expected. Going through this process might be difficult at times but it will bring peace of mind making it well worth the effort. Families that plan ahead will have fewer problems when death occurs.
