### **General Breeding Show Rules**

1. Entries can be completed online ([www.chisholmtraildorpers.com](http://www.chisholmtraildorpers.com)).
2. Shavings can be pre-purchased, or bought at check-in. Pens are set up on packed dirt floors (brand new packed arena type dirt). **Outside bedding will not be allowed!**  
**\*The wool breeds may use straw, the dirt floor or bring carpet, artificial turf or shade cloth to bed on.**
3. All breeding sheep must be registered in the recognized flock books of their respective breeds. Sheep not carrying proper ear identification at time of showing will be barred from competition. The official certificate of registration must be presented, and association ear tags or tattoos must correspond with the certificate. Applications of transfer or pending registrations will not be accepted. **Entries must be in the youth's name to qualify (partnerships between youth members are allowed).**
-  4. Youth exhibitor must be able to walk the animal in the ring and control the head of the sheep without assistance.
5. Sheep must be registered in the name of the exhibitor by the day of the show.
6. Group classes: All animals in group classes must be owned by the same owner. Entries for group classes also must be shown in their respective single classes. Group classes must be entered at time of class entries.
7. Heelers will be allowed in the breeding show, if they are exhibitors in the show as well, and 21 and under.
8. All breeding Sheep must be accompanied by a current (within 30 days) Certificate of Veterinary Inspection that meets all state requirements, issued by a certified veterinarian. **Out of state exhibitors:** Breeding rams 6 months of age or older from **out-of-state** must have a negative **Brucella Ovis ELISA test** within 30 days prior to being entered in a show, fair or exhibition, or they must come from a Brucella Ovis-free flock. The test results or herd number must be written on the certificate of veterinary inspection.
9. Animals showing signs of ringworm, fungus or other communicable diseases will not be allowed to show and must be removed from show grounds.

### Rambouillet, Delaine-Merino, Hampshire, Suffolk, Shropshire, Dorset, Southdown, Royal White & ORB Rules

1. Fitting rules – Hampshire, Suffolk, and Southdowns must be shorn above knees and hocks. Rambouillet, Delaine-Merino, Dorset, Royal White and some ORB will be shown according to their breed standard. Shropshires and Dorsets can show fitted or slick sheared.
2. **Breeding Ages:** For the purpose of this show, the following will apply regarding ages of breeding sheep: Tothing of sheep to determine the age class in which they are shown will be determined by the exhibitor before check-in. Sheep with the following tooth development at check-in time will show in the listed classes. The top 4 placing animals in each class will be toothed at the conclusion of each class. If the too thing does not match the class, the entry will be disqualified. If you are not sure about your animal's age based on teeth, please find Amanda. She can check your animal's teeth and assist you with making sure your animal is entered in the correct class.
3. Animals will show based on their teeth at the time of the show:
  - a. Lamb class – Sheep carrying all milk teeth; Lambs showing either or part of their first pair of permanent incisors may not show in the lamb classes.
  - b. 2 tooth class – Sheep showing their first pair of permanent incisors. Sheep which have dropped their central pair of milk teeth and show one or more of their first pair of permanent incisors may show in the 2 tooth class.
  - c. Aged class - 4 to 8 tooth class – Sheep showing more than their first set of permanent incisors or have dropped one or more of their milk teeth from the second set of incisors. However, sheep must not have lost any of their 8 adult permanent incisors.

## **Dorper & White Dorper Classes**

### **Dorper/White Dorper Breeding Show Rules**

1. Animals will show based on their age and cannot be moved up to show in an older class.
2. All entries must be properly sheared and washed for the show.

1. 2022 Spring Ram Lambs (born March 1, 2022 - July 1, 2022) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
2. 2022 Winter Ram Lambs (born Jan 1, 2022 - Feb 28, 2022)
3. 2021 Fall Ram Lambs (born September 1, 2021 - December 31, 2021) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
4. Yearling Rams (born September 1, 2020 – August 31, 2021)
5. Aged Rams (born August 30, 2020 or before)
6. Champion and Reserve Champion Dorper Ram
7. Pair of Rams (Rams can be any age)
8. 2022 Summer Ewe Lambs (born May 1, 2022 – July 1, 2022)
9. 2022 Spring Ewe Lambs (born March 1, 2022 - April 1, 2022) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
10. 2022 Winter Ewe Lambs (born Jan 1, 2022 - Feb 28, 2022)
11. 2021 Late Fall Ewe Lambs (born Nov. 1, 2021 - December 31, 2021)
12. 2021 Early Fall Ewe Lambs (born Sept. 1, 2021 – Oct. 31, 2021)
13. Yearling Ewes (born September 1, 2020 – August 31, 2021) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
14. Aged Ewes (born August 30, 2020 or before)
15. Champion and Reserve Champion Dorper Ewe
16. Pair of Ewes (Ewes can be any age)
17. Pair of Sheep (One Ram, One Ewe (any age))
18. Dorper Flock (One Ram (any age), Two Ewes, Two Ewe Lambs)

#### **White Dorper Division**

1. 2022 Spring Ram Lambs (born March 1, 2022 - July 1, 2022) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
2. 2022 Winter Ram Lambs (born Jan 1, 2022 - Feb 28, 2022)
3. 2021 Fall Ram Lambs (born September 1, 2021 - December 31, 2021) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
4. Yearling Rams (born September 1, 2020 – August 31, 2021)
5. Aged Rams (born August 30, 2020 or before)
6. Champion and Reserve Champion White Dorper Ram
7. Pair of Rams (Rams can be any age)
8. 2022 Summer Ewe Lambs (born May 1, 2022 – July 1, 2022)
9. 2022 Spring Ewe Lambs (born March 1, 2022 – April 30, 2022) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
10. 2022 Winter Ewe Lambs (born Jan 1, 2022 - Feb 28, 2022)
11. 2021 Late Fall Ewe Lamb (Nov. 1, 2021 – Dec. 31, 2021)
12. 2021 Early Fall Ewe Lambs (born September 1, 2021 – Oct. 31, 2021)
13. Yearling Ewes (born September 1, 2020 – August 31, 2021) \*\* Will be broken down more if entries permit.
14. Aged Ewes (born August 30, 2020 or before)
15. Champion and Reserve Champion White Dorper Ewe
16. Pair of Ewes (Ewes can be any age)
17. Pair of Sheep (One Ram, One Ewe (any age))
18. White Dorper Flock (One Ram (any age), Two Ewes, Two Ewe Lambs)

**\*\* If there are less than 5 entries in the summer ewe class it will be combined with the spring ewe class.**

**\*\*\* Winter, Spring and Summer Ewe classes can be broken down further depending on head count.**

**\*\*\*\* If there are more than 20 entries in the yearling ewe class it will be divided into a junior and senior class.**
