**AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN REGULATION AND TAXATION OF MARIHUANA ACT OF 2018, INITIATED LAW 1 OF 2018.**

St. Clair Township ordains:

**Section 1.**      **Title.** This ordinance shall be known and cited as the St Clair Township Prohibition of Marihuana Establishments Ordinance.

- Section 2. Authority.** This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Public Act 246 of 1945, Township Ordinances, MCL 41.181 et seq.
- Section 3. Purpose and Intent.** The purpose of this ordinance is to impose a ban on marijuana establishments in the boundaries of St. Clair Township to protect the health, safety and welfare of the people of St. Clair Township.
- Section 4. Definitions.** The words used herein shall have the definitions as provided for in Initiated Law 1 of 2018, as may be amended.
- Section 5. Prohibition.** Marijuana Establishments are prohibited within the boundaries of St. Clair Township pursuant to Initiated Law 1 of 2018, as may be amended.
- Section 6. Violations and Penalties.**
1. Any person who disobeys, neglects or refuses to comply with any provision of this ordinance or who causes, allows or consents to any of the same shall be deemed to be responsible for the violation of this ordinance. A violation of this ordinance is deemed to be a nuisance per se.
  2. A violation of this ordinance is a municipal civil infraction, for which fines shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$500, in the discretion of the court. The foregoing sanctions shall be in addition to the rights of the Township to proceed at law or equity with other appropriate and proper remedies. Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, which the Township incurs in connection with the municipal civil infraction.
  3. Each day during which any violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.
  4. In addition, the Township may seek injunctive relief against persons alleged to be in violation of this ordinance, and such other relief as may be provided by law.
  5. This ordinance shall be administered and enforced by the Ordinance Enforcement Officer of the Township or by such person(s) as designated by the Township Board from time to time.
- Section 7. Exemptions.** This ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit the personal use of marijuana or any actions otherwise specifically allowed pursuant to the Initiated Law 1 of 2018.
- Section 8. Validity and Severability.** If any section or provision of this ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such section or provision shall not affect the validity of any other section or provision herein, and all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 9. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective the day after its publication as authorized by law.
