

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

November 6, 2017

The Jewell County Commissioners met November 6, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. with Commissioners, Mark Fleming, Steve Greene and Keith Roe present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk, was present for the meeting.

Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director, said they marketed the cardboard for recycling last month. He reviewed the monthly activity report for October.

Shannon Meier, Ambulance Director, provided the billing report for October. Shannon said they are providing CPR training for the students at the High School. He discussed replacing the radios with digital. He had a quote from Pierce Electronics to replace the radios. The Commissioners asked Shannon to check on funding.

Steve Greene moved to not renew and terminate the employment agreement with Angela Murray with employment termination effective immediately and that the County will pay the compensation due under the agreement for the calendar year ending December 31, 2017. Mark Fleming seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Darrell Miller, County Attorney, had the real estate agreement that had been signed by Carl & Karen Figgins. Mark Fleming moved and Keith Roe seconded that the proper officer sign the real estate agreement to purchase a tract of land in the SE ¼ of Section 11 of Center Township from Carl & Karen Figgins. Motion passed unanimously.

The Commissioners presented a letter to Angela Murray, Health Administrator, stating that a motion was made and passed to terminate her employment agreement and not to renew it for 2018.

The minutes of the October 30, 2017 County Commissioners meeting were approved.

Mark Fleming moved that the proper officer sign the letter of commitment for Solomon Valley matching funds. Keith Roe seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, reported that one of the patrol cars hit a deer on October 31, 2017. Don said they were approved for a federal grant for vests in the amount \$1279.20.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, reported that they went and looked at a used 2015 International 4900 Dump Truck with snow plow.

Steve Greene moved and Keith Roe seconded to approve the request for wage change of Jack Tyler, Bridge Supervisor. Motion passed unanimously.

Doug McKinney, Executive Director and Emily Benedick, Community Development Representative of the North Central Regional Planning Commission discussed projects in Jewell County.

Dewey Underwood reported that the south half of a bridge is in need of repair located ¾ miles west of Highway 128 on R Road.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:05 a.m.
