DR. WILEY, WELL KNOWN PIGEON PHYSICAN DIES

Death Came Unexpectedly. Practiced in Pigeon 19 Years.

Dr. F. C. Wiley, died at his home in this village at 7:30 Thursday evening of last week. While the doctor had not been in the best of health for about two years he had been able to be around and do office work up to a few hours before his death. Death was caused by a cerebral hemorrhage.

Fred C. Wiley was born in Adelaide, Ontario, on July 27, 1872. He spent his boyhood days in the vicinity of his birth, later teaching a district school for two years. He attended the London Medical College for two years, going from that college to the Detroit College of Medicine from which he graduated in 1896.

After leaving college he practiced at Harrisville, Alcona county, for three years. He then located at Pinnebog in 1899, leaving there to take up practice in Pigeon in 1918.

Mr. Wiley was united in marriage to Janet Southern on November 25, 1896.
