PASTOR'S PARAGRAPHS:

From January 27 – February 17 (four Sundays), I'm going to preach from Nehemiah. Nehemiah's story (along with Ezra) tells of God's people as they try to put their lives back together after the Babylonian exile. I invite you to read through Ezra and (especially) Nehemiah to become familiar with this wonderful, though poorly known, story of God's work in the Old Testament. This story is a metaphor for the rebuilding and revitalizing of the church.

In the groups that gathered last summer and fall to talk about the future of Puckety Church, the consensus was that the "golden years" of Puckety church were either in the mid-1960s – early-1980s (when Harry Fisher was pastor) or the 1990s-2000s (when Gary Close was pastor). Since then Puckety has been on the typical Presbyterian decline – almost every Presbyterian church has experienced this – losing members and influence in the community. There are many factors that are included in this, both external (cultural, community) and internal (mistakes, conflict, etc.).

As we look toward getting a new pastor, and as we think about rebuilding the church, I invite you to think about and discuss with others the Seven Marks of Vital Congregations. I don't remember where I first got this, but these are ideas worth considering, working on together, and praying about, as we engage in this work of God. What is God doing in, among, and around Puckety Church? What is God calling us to do? What will this look like for Puckety?

Seven Marks of Vital Congregations

- 1) **Lifelong Discipleship Formation** Going beyond teaching information about God, the Bible, and how to live moral lives, offering opportunities to continue the journey of faith.
- 2) **Intentional Authentic Evangelism** Intentionally sharing the good news of Jesus, not just being nice people and doing good works.
- 3) **Outward Incarnational Focus** A missional focus, into our community and into the world, where Christ is already living and present and calling us to dwell.
- 4) **Empowered Servant Leadership** Identifying, nurturing and supporting the use of spiritual gifts of all people. Less of a focus on "it's the pastor's job."
- 5) **Spirit-Inspired Worship** Worship that isn't self-gratifying but focuses on God and ultimately challenges, transforms and sends people out differently.
- 6) **Caring Relationships** Creating a place where people can freely share stories, ask questions and be loved through the struggles of life.
- 7) **Ecclesial Health** Understanding why a church community comes together. Being open to changes. Nurturing and supporting the health of the pastor, staff, and all who are called to lead and participate in the church.

April 5-6, 2019


Come join us for a wonderful time of worship and fellowship, to help us grow closer to Jesus, that's just for women!


individual mac and cheese servings
