I've watched the Western Intercollegiate tournament on TV for several years, but now I have a new appreciation for the difficulty of the Augusta like greens and the importance of approach angles.

So, whatever is on your bucket list, I urge you to do it. And if it includes Bandon, do it while you can still walk 18-36 holes a day!

Tournament News

When the clouds broke and the sun came out, we enjoyed a great day of weather for this year's ILN 5-4-3 out tournament. We had 103 golfers and paid out \$4,409 to 55 players. The 50/50 drawing winners were: Albert Armijo, Sean Verne, and Nick Sanchez - each received \$95 pot money. Congratulations to all the winners!

Golf Genius update: Online signups were opened on March 27th for the 5-4-3 out tournament. Maybe a little early but allowed plenty of time to register. We had 35 messages from members received in Golf Genius' email inbox, which is a big increase in usage over what we've been averaging for tournaments. Keep in mind that once we close signups





and calibrate flights in GG, the golf course is notified, and they sell our unused tee times to the public. Regarding the latter, I thank Art and the Golf Shop for being flexible with tee times always accommodating our tournaments and skins games. But we as a club must do our part too, by remembering to sign up on time and understanding that once the field is set, last-minute additions typically cannot be accommodated. However, if you missed signing up for an event, inquire with us anyway as it never fails that there are a few last-minute cancellations, and it might work out.

For new club members, it's important to get familiar with signing up for our events online and on time. Be sure your handicap reflects your true golfing abilities. For all members, I share one observation from the results of the ILN 5-4-3 Out tournament in how close the final leaderboard was in all flights. No one golfer ran away from the field once the dust settled! Trust me, we're getting better as time passes using the tools and analytics available through the USGA which helps provide fair competition. New members are encouraged to participate in our Tuesday's and Saturday's Skins games. This will allow us to meet you, and you meet us! So please come out and play more rounds at El Prado Golf Courses!

May 11th is our next tournament, the 2 Man 4 Clubs – Red Tees Better Ball.

Look for on-line signups to open early again! Tournament signups will close Tuesday May 7th. Sign your team up early to guarantee a spot. Online signups will close earlier if the player limit is reached before May 7th. We will confirm the roster of players in email on Wednesday May 8th before the tournament, and release tee times and pairings Friday May 10th.

It's a TEAM event and only one member needs to signup/register the team in GG.

When signups open, please follow these steps to register:

Step 1. <u>You or your Playing Partner</u> will need to navigate through the signup confirmation buttons by checking playing.

Step 2. Click on the <u>signup other members</u> link and add your playing partner's name.

Step 3. If you choose - you or your Playing Partner can <u>SEND message to the manager</u> either noting your TEAM PAIRING and/or include any special requests in your message.

Step 4. Hit the SEND button.

The tee sheet link in Golf Genius will populate names for the confirmed list of players. Pairings will not appear until TEAMS are made on the back end in Golf Genius. Be assured we will monitor signups closely and communicate with you if there are any issues. Registered players should get a Golf Genius automated signup confirmation email.

Finally, it will be important this month to talk early with your team partner and make sure they are playing before you sign up! If you are a single with no partner, please sign up as a single making a note in Golf Genius to the manager and we will try our best to pair you up with another single. Remember that we cap our tournament size and will place players on a waitlist if reached. If you're lost in the signup process, or need any assistance please communicate with us.

This month is the 2 Man 4 Clubs – Red Tees Better Ball tournament - AB flights will be on Chino Creek and CD flights will be on Butterfield.

We had some reports of players bumping the ball in the tournament, which is not allowed. There were three signs on the check in table, and it was printed in the rules, so no excuses for not knowing. There is no free relief from bare spots or divots or footprints, except as described in our local rules. If you question a player taking free relief, and they don't agree with you, they should play two balls and then talk to the committee for a ruling before you turn in your scorecard.
