Cardboard

(Please break down to 2ft.x2ft.)



Boxboard, cereal type boxes, corrugated cardboard, product and clean food packaging boxes such as cereal, pasta, pizza, and tissue, paperboard boxes, beverage holders, paper towel cores, toilet paper cores, and paper bags.

Glass

Clean food and beverage containers and jars of any color



Metal

Clean household and kitchen items such as aluminum cans (soda and pet food cans), pie plates, trays, foil, tin cans, (food cans, coffee cans, and pet food cans), and small steel containers



Paper

Newspaper, opened junk mail, envelopes, magazines, soft cover books, file folders, any color paper, egg cartons

Plastic



Containers, bottles and jugs #1-#7 (# located on the bottom of container) such as food, beverage, beauty, and cleaning products, detergents, dairy tubs such as yogurt and sour cream, plastic take-out containers, flower pots and trays, large rigid plastic items such as: 5-gallon buckets, sleds, soda crates, laundry baskets, plastic chairs, carts, and garbage cans

Not Accepted in the Zero Sort Container at Waste USA, but can go in the trash:

plastic bags, window glass, mirrors, non-fluorescent light bulbs, dishes, pyrex, ceramics, used paper towels & facial tissue, styrofoam, recyclables containing food waste, VCR tapes, CDs/DVDs



Composters

The town clerk's office is currently selling composters for \$25 each. The Casella Waste Management, Inc. is also selling them at the landfill on Airport Rd. They are \$35 for your first one, and \$50 after that. Prices are subject to change.

Accepted in the Waste USA Metal Bin:

Large Bulky Metal Discard Including: Stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, water heaters, copper piping, steel & aluminum scraps, bicycles, metal exercise equipment, empty handheld propane tanks, car parts/rims, metal office furniture, grills, empty metal drums, microwaves, metal roofing, large metal objects

****NOT ACCEPTED**—containers with oils or chemicals (HHWD), electronic waste (see back), Freon containing items (unless certified otherwise), larger propane tanks, batteries

Accepted in the Waste USA Yard Waste

Bin: Christmas trees, branches, leaves, stumps

****NOT ACCEPTED**—construction debris, wood with nails in it, wood that is painted, stained, varnished, or otherwise treated
