COVID-19 Update

Good Afternoon from Midway Nursing Home –

This is your weekly COVID-19 information update. There have been no new COVID-19 cases for residents or staff. Limited in person, visitation resumed on 10/20/20 and has been going very well.

Visits must be scheduled in advance, is limited to two persons and each visitors required to present negative COVID-19 test result from a test that was conducted in the 7 day period prior to the visit. It is highly recommended that you schedule your visit at Midway before you take your test to assure that you are within the proper time frame for results. Residents on isolation for any reason are not permitted visitors per NYSDOH guidance.

If weather permits, visitation is outdoors. Visits are scheduled according to the floor the resident resides on as follows:

Monday – 4th floor; Tuesday – 5th floor; Wednesday - 6th floor; Thursday – 3rd floor & Friday – 2nd floor. There is no weekend visitation currently.

Please arrive 15 minutes in advance of your scheduled time to allow for the required COVID screening process. While on facility property, a face mask must always be worn. Social distance of at least 6 feet must always be maintained and no one under the age of 18 is permitted to visit per NYSDOH guidance.

All medical appointments outside the facility except dialysis or other medically emergent visits continue to be curtailed as well as out on pass.

Virtual visits remain available daily. Please contact Social Work or Recreation to arrange this.
