2. We could also use some individuals who would be willing to provide singing of either liturgical parts or hymns. 3. We hope to have an interactive Wednesday evening event for those who would like to have spiritual conversations. More details will be coming....
4. Some committees will continue to meet on a case by case basis. Please contact your committee chair for more details.
5. We have set up a network to help deliver items to those unable to get out. If you are in need of a delivery, please contact Janet Koerner at (859-277-0242). Janet will reach out to our volunteers and set up a time

6. As of today, we will still be helping families in need of food at Garden Springs Elementary School. Amy Minarik (859-492-5640) is now our lead person on this ministry. We are also helping those connected to Gethsemane with basic needs (food, rent, etc.).
 7. Please contact Pastor Laura directly (859-230-5735) if you have any pastoral needs.
 8. Please continue to reach out to at least five (5) family members or neighbors during this time. Pay special attention to those who are home-bound [shut-ins, self-isolating/self-quarantining], those in nursing homes, and those who may be out of work [restaurant workers, and service individuals]. Call and ask to pray with them. Send cards and letters. As the Apostle Paul wisely stated in 1 Cor 12:22-23 "The members of the body [of Christ] that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and those members of the body that we think less honorable we clothe with greater honor."
 9. Please continue to wash your hands for 20 seconds and use hand sanitizer regularly to protect yourselves and others.
 10. As your income allows, please continue to support our ministry here. There are numerous ways you can do this:
