There are a few more instructions here as there are newer members included here that have never been to National Convention, so please bear with the obvious to you veteran conventioners. Thanks!

Remember that reservations are made through our Department office, time stamped, manually or as emailed. Attendees are responsible for their own travel arrangements. I also attached the form.

The hotel does not accept direct reservations during this period until after we have claimed all the rooms that we contracted. By "we," I include the hand full of other Departments in our same hotel. If you stay somewhere other than our contracted hotel, you must still be registered as an Arizona attendee using our form. Simply write across the top of the form "no hotel room needed." This is not easily changed so please be certain before you commit such.

Delegates who report on meetings MUST stay at our contracted hotel. These meetings are held over the weekend. Please do not accept an appointment unless you are certain to attend. The roll call is taken. Business attire is highly recommended.

When not in meetings or other mandates, Delegates are expected to be in attendance on the Convention floor unless your travel requirements pull you away sooner. Business attire is highly recommended. Breaks are at will, but be sure to wear your credentials at all times or you will not be permitted onto the Convention business floor or hospitality rooms later each evening.

If a US Government dignitary is confirmed to attend, you will be screened stringently for access to the floor once the building has been secured for the day.

The Hospitality room operation requests of Arizona visitors, \$5.00 donation for each day of visit to the room and its amenities. We do not ask this of visiting Department' delegates. You can expect that same hospitality from other Departments when you visit them and make new friends, or connect with those whom you miss from last year.

By the way, I'll soon know which room that we will be using for hospitality and that room is the same room that you'll come to for your Convention registration credentials and information packets and any tickets that you purchase for activities through the Department of Arizona.

The Arizona Dinner on Saturday night 8/29/2020, will be a dinner/river cruise. The \$50.00 price is lower this year as we are not hiring a bus to drive us the 4 blocks to the river edge. Dress comfortably. I can assist with accommodations where needed. Simply ask and please also note it on your reservation form. We fondly refer to our party as, "The ANW-MO Party" because our tradition is to co-locate our fun as Arizona, New Mexico, Wyoming & Missouri. Lots of friends to see!

There will be a parade on Sunday for us to walk in. Departments also hold all manner of gatherings to relax around before the business of Convention begins, not to mention the local sights and activities.
