## March 1st Rockfish Opener Aboard The Pacific Dawn By Luke Fitzpatrick

Myself and 17 others departed at 10pm on Tuesday the 28th in hopes of some good freezer filling rockfish the following day. After a few bumps and rolls while heading out of the harbor things flattened out and we had a fairly smooth ride that just continued to smooth out through the night.

The following morning, after a few cups of coffee, we slid onto our first stop and Pat hollered at us to go for it! I grabbed my 9' Phenix and Lexa 400 with a 6oz diamond jig and from the bow cast out. After what seemed like forever I finally hit bottom and was bit almost immediately. While cussing myself for using a paddle handled reel for deep water rockfish I proceeded to slowly crank up a really nice Bosco. Well, after a 100lb Mako taxed me, it was half of a really nice Bosco.

My contribution to out boat limits was 5 Reds, 6 Johnny bass, 2 chucklehead, 1 bocaccio, ½ of a bosco and 7 legal lingcod Not a bad way to start the season at all!
