

## Amendments to forms

### Amendment I:

Form: How to Qualify for National Championship Team

Previous statement:

- 2.2 Competitions include, but are not limited to, any collegiate, national, or Texas A&M Trap and Skeet sponsored events, including Maroon 100s.
- 2.2.1 If a member participates in a competition where Texas A&M Trap and Skeet is not an actively competing team, then that member must submit a scorecard signed by an official from the hosting party of the competition in order for the score to be included on the master club member rankings.

New, amended statement:

- 2.2 Qualifying competitions are considered collegiate competitions where Texas A&M is an actively competing collegiate team.
- 2.2.1 Exceptions can be made by the current officer committee to those who are members of, and compete in, national shooting tournaments hosted by NSCA, USAS, ATA, NSSA, and alike organizations.

Reasoning for change:

The current officers saw the opportunity for members to compete in shoots, more specifically sporting clays, where targets can be set easier to achieve high scores for paying participants. This being the case, the last wording allowed for these shoots to qualify for the national championship team. The officers considered that some fundraiser sporting clays shoot's difficulties do not reflect that of the National Championship course difficulty.
