Registrations for the 2023-2024 bi-weekly sessions of faith development / family catechism for St. Augustine's or St. Lawrence O'Toole will be taking place Sunday, September 10th from 12:15 – 1:30 pm in the church basement of St. Augustine's.



Our faith development/family catechism is for families with children ages 6-12 who have been baptized in the Catholic faith. The sessions are for both the parent & child as our program involves interaction between parent & child. We ask that if the parent is not available, the child attend with an adult they are comfortable with. We meet bi-weekly for 1.5 hours and our program uses music, videos, slides, crafts & games to engage the children in developing their faith.

The faith development/family catechism program is the structure that helps to form the children's faith especially those that will be receiving sacraments. **Please know that all children must have at least one year of faith development/family catechism prior to preparing to receive a sacrament.**

You can submit the form online or print the form (using the word or pdf document) and drop it off at our office or in the collection basket at mass.

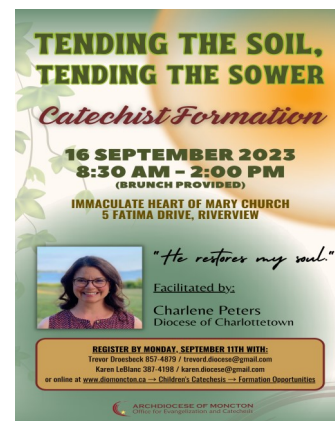
