Home for the Holidays

I have found myself to be guilty of not fully appreciating the miracles that play out through the course of the daily grind and steps of faith that don't always connect immediately to an end result. It's because of this that I feel prompted to share God's faithfulness over the course of the past nearly two years and His perfect, perfect timing. Our family moved into a neighboring county 4 years ago and a couple years into being settled in it became evident that God was telling me to pursue having our home become a certified foster home again. At the time, there were 6 children in the home and life was quite full most days, so "Why now, God?" seemed like an obvious and reasonable question. The answer came in a manner that no one else has ever or will ever be able to communicate with me and my heart...it came through a solid assurance, an inaudible voice though the depths that I have learned to not ignore-

His voice: "Trust Me."

So the process began and it completed in January of 2023. "Now we wait." What I would later find out is that just 2 weeks after this, there were 2 children in our same village we live in who were abruptly removed from a foster home they had lived in for over 5 years, the vast majority of their young 8 and 7 year old lives. They were removed due to abuse in the foster home, a foster home that would have likely been an adoptive home, but God intervened. Over the next few months, our home was not called upon to help, but rather these two children went to two other foster homes both of which proved to be not the permanent homes intended for them. Their last placement was with a 73 year old woman who committed to God to care for them until their forever home was found. Our home received a call in May and we began

having the children come over for respite which led to eventually a permanent placement in August. Fast forward to September of this year, just over a year later, and the adoption of these two children was finalized and I know this was an answer to two children's prayers for a number of years as they just want a home and family that will be permanent and solid. The day of the adoption came and went and I am still astounded by God's faithfulness, by the fact that things have moved smoothly and beautifully, by His timing being so perfect. This year as we prepare for all of the family festivities and traditions, I have to pause and appreciate the miracle of what He has done as two more voices can be heard calling me "Mom" and two more lives have accepted the greatest gift of all, the gift of salvation, and I am eager to watch the future unfold for these precious children and all God has in store for them. For those of you who prayed and those of you who will be from this point forward, we are so grateful.
