

I lift my voice. I cry out for justice against the indignities, the horrors, the rapes and the slaughter of the Biafran People for over 70 years. I am delighted to join my voice with the Biafran community and the world of supporters who pray and long for your freedom from such vile oppression.

I hope to see more evidence that Prime Minister Theresa May shares no similar sentiment with the former British Prime Minister Harold Wilson, who said that he “could take 500,000 Biafran deaths if that is what it took” to continue stealing and raping Biafra of her oil. While we do not impugn such depravity against any British official today, we ask the leaders of Great Britain, the Netherlands, and America, with the strongest voice of concern about these recent atrocities:

- Where was your outcry and condemnation of the 30-100 innocent, unarmed Biafrans shot dead simply for celebrating President Trump’s Inauguration? ⁱ
- Where is your outcry of the daily rapes of our Biafran wives and daughters?
- Where is your outcry of the 5000 people displaced from their homes on Mbatoho Island on February 28, 2018?ⁱⁱ
- Where is your outcry against the thousands of innocent Biafrans who have been slaughtered within the past year by the world’s most savage terrorist organization, the Fulani Herdsmen?
- Where is your condemnation of the slaughter of those in Nnamdi Kanu’s household?
- Where is the concern for the human rights of Nnamdi Kanu? Can the wealthiest of nations do more to protect a brother who shares your same desire for peace and freedom?ⁱⁱⁱ
- Where is the outcry of the 75 people slaughtered by the Fulani Herdsmen on February 6, 2018?^{iv}

These are only a very few examples.

We, of the free world concerned for the oppressed, rejoice with all those nations who seek and uphold the human right of self-preservation, the human right to possess one’s own resources, and the human right to live within the borders of one’s own country. We call the world’s attention to the 10-year-old ***United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples***, adopted 13 September, 2007^v

We call upon the British Petroleum Company and the once Christian Nation of Great Britain, we call upon the Shell Oil Company and the waning Christian Government of the Netherlands, and we call upon Exxon-Mobil and the once God-fearing American Government to change course. We ask that these nations join the other freedom loving nations of the world and vote within this year, 2018, to declare Biafra a Sovereign Nation with all the rights therein.

We ask these three nations to halt the seventy-year sanctioning of the nightmare of rapes, slaughter, torture, beheadings, and the continuous immoral subjugation of the peaceful Biafran Christians. It must finally come to an end. And it will come to an end as you join your Biafran

Christian Brothers and sisters and pray, diligently and sincerely, for the cessation of the filthy blood lust and the theft of Biafran oil and the right of the Biafran people to their own beautiful Biafran Homeland.

Remember the screams of the Biafran daughters in your ears as they are being raped simply for being Christians. Do not forget the cries of the Biafran sons whose limbs are torn and ripped from their bodies simply because they are Biafrans. And, yes, listen to the cries of the millions who you sanctified to starvation, to torture and to death who still moan through the heavens and the earth seeking solace, seeking comfort, seeking some nation that will care about the generations of Biafrans who continue to be slaughtered each day. Who will share Biafra's inexpressible sorrow? The world has so soon forgotten. The Biafran people are owed an apology from the world equal to the genocide perpetrated against them. ^{vi}

In closing, I would like to make two comments.

1. First, I am very grateful to you, President Trump for, bringing in a new United States Secretary of State at the end of this month. This provides hope that there may be a change from the from the continued pro-Islamic oil coalition and the anti-freedom and anti-Biafran path of the past seventy years. We look forward to working with Secretary Mike Pompeo.
2. Secondly, Save Biafra for freedom, Mr. President. According to your own belief in freedom, save preserve the honor of the free people of Biafra. In preparation of Secretary Tillerson's visit to Nigeria and Africa, Ambassador Yamamoto said, "... we call Africa the "final frontier" for freedom and opportunity, and really that is the answer."^{vii}

Yes, Mr. President. That is the answer. Africa IS the "final frontier" for freedom and opportunity. But if you and the free world refuse to stand with Biafra for *their* freedom, if you and the United Nations refuse to grant Biafra the Rights of Indigenous People for *their* people and their land, and *their* resources, and *their* country, if you continue to send your Consul General and Ambassador to Nigeria to tacitly watch the Biafran lovers of freedom and democracy be decimated and subjugated, if you continue to cover your ears as they are systematically slaughtered, as Britain and the Netherlands have done, then there will be no free Africa. Biafra, along with the whole African Continent, will all be subjugated to the savage Theocracy of Islam. Biafra is diametrically opposed to that deceitful, vile and barbaric culture which surrounds rules them.

Save Biafra, Mr. President. Save them from the continuous slaughter and bloodshed that literally consumes their flesh. And Biafra will rise as another light for the nations. Biafra will shine as a beacon of freedom to the world.
