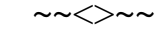

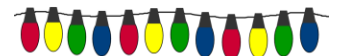

**November Program "Rock the Boat"**

**Gravy Boat usages**  
by **Bonnie Theard**



Bonnie got the idea from an article about Gravy Boats, floral arrangement, etc in Southern Lady magazine. The history of gravy boats came from French sauce bowls in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. Usually oval shaped with spouts and handles, called "sausiere", sitting on matching dish with or without spoons.

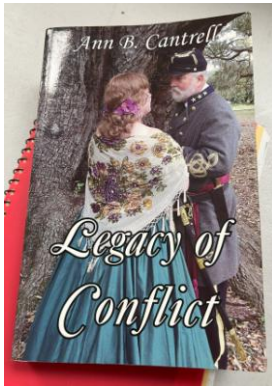
American sauce boats appeared around 1725-30, sometimes called Butter Boats. They were used for butter or gravy when serving meat and vegetables.

But today's gravy boats can be used for much more: milk for cereal, sauces for desserts, or salad dressings. Also used for utensils at a buffet, flower arrangements, soap or bath salts, or potpourris.

Most displayed here are China with the exception of Florentine #2 made by Hazel Atlas Glass Co. 1932-35. It comes with an oval platter that Bonnie uses for Asparagus with Hollandaise sauce in the gravy boat.
