Newbridge were at full tilt in this game as they routed a New Ross team in every aspect of play. In full flight now Newbridge were quickly into the running as centre Denis O'Callaghan made good headway up the pitch to give the ball to wing forward Mark Doyle to score near the corner in the 18th minute. New Ross's defence was at full stretch now when winger Liam Donovan carried the ball beating three defenders to touch down under the posts after 26 minutes. McGovern converted. Five minutes later Burns was on hand to burst through the New Ross defence to score after a good carry from second row Rory McCann.

Up now stepped the Newbridge Captain Ronan Mangan as he went over in the 63rd minute for his first try. McGovern converted. In the 69th minute a quick drop off from the 22-metre line was collected by Brendan Tiernan who made an incisive run and passed to Mangan who duly obliged with the try which was converted by McGovern. Ian O'Rahilly replaced hooker Matt Duggan in the 71st minute. The final fling was made by the Newbridge scrum as they drove the opposition over the line for No. 8 Mangan to get his third try.
