## Public Works info:

- Grass is being cut regularly throughout the summer to control pests and snakes.
- Roads are being repaired with gravel, those roads that have the most damage are being repaired first.

- A tree trimming company has been cutting tree branches that hang over roads or that are hazardous; this is being done on an ongoing as-needed basis.
