

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

TOWN OF KREMMLING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
January 18, 2017

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Thomas Clark called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Trustees present: Scott Crandall, Gina Schroeder, Jason Wikberg, Wes Howell, Guy Bakke, and Grace Bohall. Staff present: Town Manager Mark Campbell, Public Works Director Jason Bock, and Town Clerk Rhonda Shearer.

CRANDALL MOVED TO ACCEPT THE REGULAR PROCEEDINGS FOR JANUARY 4, 2017. HOWELL SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

SCHROEDER MOVED TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURES FROM JANUARY 5, 2017 THROUGH JANUARY 18, 2017 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$118,612.02. WIKBERG SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

WIKBERG MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. HOWELL SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

There were no citizen comments.

The design committee had some updated information regarding the proposed new wayfaring signs. The actual placement of the signs may have to be moved depending on the location of underground utilities.

The Mayor reported:

- We are no longer considered to be in drought conditions.

There was no police chief report. Manager Campbell did note that officer Dillons car is in the shop. The new police truck is here, and should be in service in the next few weeks.

The Public Works Director reported:

- The rain we recently had made for interesting conditions, but his crew stayed on top of things, and there were no major issues.


The Manager reported:

- He received a written request from the Grand County Council on Aging for \$2500, and he had already budgeted for this.

BAKKE MOVED TO GRANT THE \$2500 FOR GRAND COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

- He attended the Grand County Commissioners meeting, where the Bureau of Land Management was discussing additional closures to the Wolford Mountain area. It was decided that for now they will use snow berms to keep vehicles off of the closed roads.
