



The mission of the Auxiliary Operations Division is: to provide oversight assistance, and support for surface operations of the Coast Guard Auxiliary; to further the education and accident prevention of Recreational Boating Safety; and to assist the United States Coast Guard when it calls upon the Auxiliary.

### Surface Water Missions-

**Safety Patrol** - Patrol under Coast Guard orders using an Auxiliary Operational Facility.

**Regatta Patrol** - Patrolling organized regattas and boat parades.

**PWC Patrol** - Patrolling on a Personal Water Craft (PWC).

**SAR Mission** - Search And Rescue call out or the air equivalent to a vessel safety patrol. .

**Training Mission** - Training missions involving air operations.

**Marine Vessel Examinations** - Vessel Safety Checks, Personal Water Craft Safety Checks, Paddle Vessel's and Commercial Fishing/Hire Vessel.

### Land Operations Missions-

**Telecommunication Operator**- Serving as a qualified watch-stander at a Coast Guard Auxiliary facility.

**SAR Call Out** - Search And Rescue call out involving communication facilities.

**CG Crew Augmentation** - Serving as a qualified crew on active duty Coast Guard vessels.

**Enforcement of Laws and Treaties** - Providing surface support of Coast Guard law enforcement mission.

**Marine Vessel Examinations** - Vessel Safety Checks, Personal Water Craft Safety Checks, Paddle Vessel's and Commercial Fishing/Hire Vessel.

**Public Affairs Mission** - Promoting the Coast Guard, Coast Guard Auxiliary and Coast Guard Reserve.

**Marine Dealer Visits** - Participating in the Marine Dealer Visitation Program.

### Public Education Missions-

**Boater Safety Classes** - Auxiliary multi-lesson public education classes, and North Carolina certificate.

**Boy Scout Motorboat Badge Education**- Boating Safety Classes for local Troops and provide youth courses.

**Member Training Instructor Mission** - Member training; boats crew training, Instructor, and operational qualifications.

### Environmental Missions-

**Marine Environmental Protection** - Provide support to the Team Coast Guard mission in regards to Marine Environmental Protection and Natural Resources.

### Coast Guard Support Missions-

**CG Operational Support** - A service provided to operational Coast Guard units in support of Coast Guard programs.

**AIM Mission** - The Auxiliary's Academy Introduction Mission (AIM).

**RAP Mission** - Coast Guard Recruiting Assistance Program (RAP).

**Public Affairs Mission** - Promoting the Coast Guard, Coast Guard Auxiliary and Coast Guard Reserve.

**Marine Dealer Visits** - Participating in the Marine Dealer Visitation Program.

### Agency Support Missions-

**Federal Agencies** - Provide both non-operational and operational support to other federal agencies.

**State Agencies** - Provide support to state agencies, such as Wild Life Police and Marine Patrols.

**Local Agencies** - Provide support to local agencies, such as local police, sheriff's offices, and EMS/ Rescue.
