2017 Golf Tournament and Luncheon – June 19th at Country Club of North Carolina

The 21st Annual John Reburn Memorial Golf Tournament will be held on Monday, June 19, 2017 at CCNC (DOGWOOD COURSE). We are also having a Luncheon Meeting after the tournament at the CCNC Clubhouse. We are expecting 120 golfers and can accommodate 200 for lunch, so come to the luncheon even if you do not wish to play golf.

Again this year we are going to sponsor First Responders as our guests.

Our objective is to have all Moore County Republican Men's Club members participate in some way! This is our golf fundraiser as we move toward the important general election in November 2018.

Please see the participation/application form on the back of this announcement for details and prices. The golf will be a Florida scramble (aka "walk away," selected shot sits out except on the green) with a shotgun start at 8:00 am. We are asking our MRW, MTC and Moore GOP friends to participate in golf and attend the luncheon. Women will tee off from the front red tees. Men 51 and older will tee off from the white tees. Men 50 or under will tee off from the blue tees. *This year, we again have a "Kitchen Sink Package" which is used for mulligans and/or beers if not otherwise used. Purchase of a Kitchen Sink Package for \$20 will include 2 mulligans or beers and 2 chances for a \$250 Golf Shop Credit raffle to be drawn at lunch.*

Golf fees include lunch. For those who do not wish to play golf we ask that you consider sponsoring a hole (\$125 - use your name or a business, must be paid by an individual), sponsor a First Responder (\$150), make a donation (Eagle-\$150 [includes lunch], Birdie-\$100, Par-\$50, or other \$ amount) and/or come for the luncheon meeting at 12:30pm (\$25). Golf awards (winning teams, closest to the pin, closest to the line, etc.) prizes and the raffle during lunch will be in the form of CCNC golf shop credit. In the case of very bad weather, the luncheon event will go on and signed up golfers will be given a rain check for later play. The golf awards will be given after lunch.

Luncheon meeting will be at 12:30pm. We hope to again have Congressman Richard Hudson join us to greet golfers and make some short remarks after lunch. He is now our new Congressman as a result of the redrawn districts. We will have any other special guests introduce themselves and speak briefly.
