is a performance coach, director and performer, active in the Seattle region for more than 20 years. She has a Masters in Acting, with training in physical theatre styles ranges from ballet to stage combat, commedia to tap, Suzuki stomping to trapeze and other circus arts. She built 10 years' experience as a professional stage actor before she moved into recording, songwriting, directing, and coaching.
