

Are You Keeping The Commandment?

On one occasion a scribe asked Jesus, "Which is the first commandment of all?" — or which is the most important commandment? "And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment" (Mark 12:29-30 KJV).

The most important attribute that *anyone* can possess is being **A Lover Of God**. Jesus said that the love of God must be first and most important in our lives. We are to love God "with all (our) heart." This means that we are to love God with all of our feelings, desires, emotions, affections, and longings. We are to love God "with all (our) soul," that is to say, we are to love God with all our life, with our very being. We are to love God "with all (our) mind" — which involves our intellect. And we are to love God "with all (our) strength." We love God with intensity and action. Love is the fundamental commandment underlying the whole of God's law. It involves our total being and loyalty.

Consider these words of Jesus Christ: "If you love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15 KJV). Decades later, the apostle John wrote by inspiration of the Holy Spirit, "For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and His commandments are not grievous" (1 John 5:3 KJV).

There are so many people in our world, and even in the church, who *claim* to love God but their actions speak differently — their actions declare just the opposite. There is a temptation to dismiss obedience as a sort of legalism that was abolished under the new covenant. Is that what the Lord teaches in the above-mentioned verses? If we really love the Lord with all of our heart, soul, mind, and strength, then we *will keep the Almighty's command-ments*.

The old law with all of its details about tithing, holy days, retributions, animal sacrifices, etc. has been nailed to the cross. Yet, obedience is still the key to loving God! Do you know the life and teachings of the son of God? Do you really love God?

"Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven" (Matthew 7:21 KJV).
