

**DELEGATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR SALE OF CHOMETZ
FOR CORPORATIONS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF
THE VAAD HAKASHRUTH OF THE CAPITAL DISTRICT**

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Bomzer to act on my behalf to sell all chometz possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) as defined by the Torah and Rabbinic law (e.g., chometz, doubt of chometz, all kinds of chometz mixtures); also chometz that tends to harden and adhere to a surface of inside of pans and pots or cooking and usable utensils and all kinds of live animals that have been eating chometz or mixtures thereof, and to lease all places wherein the chometz owned by me may be found, especially on the premises located at:

and elsewhere. The approximate value is \$ _____. This includes transit goods that would be delivered to me during the period from late morning Wednesday, April 8 through Thursday night, April 16, 2020, inclusive. Rabbi Bomzer has the full right to sell and to lease my transactions as he deems fit and proper for such time which they believe necessary, to a non-Jew of his choosing.

Also, I hereby give Rabbi Bomzer full power and authority to appoint a substitute in his stead with full power to sell and lease as provided.

The buyer has free access to all "Chometz" acquired by them. At the same time, and by virtue of this sale, the Company sells to the buyer, all of its inventory including raw ingredients, products being produced and products already produced. It is understood and agreed that all profits and losses from the said productions, marketing and sales of the products shall belong to and be the responsibility of the buyer.

The above-given power is in conformity with all Torah and Rabbinical regulations and laws and also in accordance with the laws of the State of New York and of the United States.
