- B. Houdesheldt NCWA/CVWB Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program update CVWB have hired a new "Water Quality Coordinator Liaison". She will be going on tours in Shasta/Tehama counties starting next Monday. The CVWB and NCWA are working on exempting no nitrogen pastureland in Shasta/Tehama counties.

Maricle presented on water quality monitoring for the IRLP program and its effects on requirements and regulations moving forward.
