SCIENCE

As Scientists we will be investigating the senses and how we can keep our bodies and mind healthy. Each week we will learn about a new organ, its functions and its purpose. At the end of the half term we will have learnt about our brains, hearts, lungs, kidneys and stomach.

COMPUTING

We will be learning basic skills including typing, saving, simple editing, undo and redo.

ENRICHMENT

The children will take part in Forest School exploring the outdoor environment. Marvellous Me boxes - family project - children make a box with personal objects in to introduce themselves to the class.

HUMANITIES

As Historians, we will be creating family trees and thinking about who is in our family. We will look at how we have changed between birth and now for example: appearance, hobbies and interests.

On-going skills - identifying seasonal/daily weather patterns.

MATHS

As mathematicians we will be reading and writing numbers to 100, solving practical problems with measures, know the days of the week and the months of the year, practice adding and subtracting.

As Artists we will be creating clay tiles of our faces and finishing them with paint. We will be experimenting with a range of media to create portraits and pictures of ourselves.

MUSIC

As Musicians we will be playing untuned/percussion instruments and singing songs linked to our theme.

PE

PE will focus on 'Sending and Receiving', using small equipment to develop children's hand/eye coordination and aim. The children will also work on large apparatus focussing on different ways to travel and perform a variety of rolls.

SEAL

We will thinking about making our classroom fair and safe for all, belonging to a group or community and the importance of friendship.

RE

In RE we will be looking at the theme of 'Belonging'. Learning about how babies are welcomed into the Christian church - Christenings.
