**NEW JERSEY JEWELER REPORTS POSSIBLE CASING**

A retail jeweler in Bridgewater, NJ reported the following incident which she believed to be suspicious.

On Wednesday, April 1, just after 6:00 PM, an African-American male entered the store. He was wearing a wool cap though it was a warm day, seemed to be deliberately avoiding the security cameras, asked to see the store's most expensive diamond earrings then asked for the most expensive gold Rolex watch. He twice flashed a wad of cash and repeatedly looked out a car that was parked outside. He received a call on his cell phone then left in a new white BMW with NY plates and with three other African-American males inside.

The man later called the store looking to speak with the associate that helped him and advised that he would be coming back later in the week to buy a gold watch.

Please note that as of this report, we know of no crime being committed. This incident is being reported because there were enough signs to make the jeweler concerned that a crime might be committed.
