Step 2: *Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.*

This step is linked to the Spiritual Principle of **HOPE** – To expect with desire; something on which hopes are centered.

Starting to believe in, or accept the notion of a power greater than ourselves. How we define that is up to us, but define it we must – at least in a most general way.

Self directed control has not worked and therefore we need an open mind to accept a change.

Willing to believe in something other than ourselves – something that we can turn to for help. In the beginning this might be the group itself. Our definition doesn't need to be very specific at all, just the acceptance that somehow, some way a Power greater than ourselves can restore us to sanity.
