Orchestra Fees

All students will be charged a \$70 program operation fee for the current school year. Anyone using a school instrument will also be charged a district required \$50 instrument rental fee. Both of these fees can be paid online on our orchestra website through a site called Ludus. There is a 5% fee charged for using Ludus. Checks may also be brought to the orchestra room safe. All checks should be made out to McKinney ISD. No cash will be accepted.
