### Happy Father's Day!

This Sunday we celebrate Father's Day. A recent article from The Knights of Columbus magazine ("Dad's Big Day - and Influence" by Soren Johnson) "Columbia" had a sobering quote about the importance of fathers in regards to a person's faith: "Citing a 2000 report in the journal "Population Studies", author Eric Sammons observes, "Only 2% of kids whose fathers don't practice the faith will end up practicing that faith!" While many studies highlight the significant influence of mothers in other areas, research points to a distinctive edge that dads have on their children's religion outlook. If dads disengage from faith, their kids are prone to dismiss it."

- 3 I went with my dad to a lot of Notre Dame home football games in my twenties. My first game was the week after they beat Miami at home. They played Rice and there was a cold rain with everybody drinking hot chocolate. They won of course and went on to win the National Championship that year!
- 4 We have gone to several concerts together including Trans Siberian Orchestra, Texas Tenors, Alabama, Air Supply, Neil Diamond, and Celine Dion. Neil Diamond was the best concert. He has so many hit songs. He ended with my favorite song of his- "America."
- 5 We have shared many meals at Applebee's and he always orders the Clubhouse Grill sandwich. He eats half of it at the restaurant and takes the other half home for another meal. I would be shocked if he ever ordered something else. I guess if you find something you like, then keep going back to it.
- 6 My dad continues to be part of the Family Fantasy Football league and Draft Day is always a fun time. He certainly contributes to that fun. He has two championships for our league. Way to go Dad!
- 7 Let me end on a serious note. There was a period of time when I was unemployed, and I wondered if I would ever get back on my feet again. My dad invited me to a Christ Renews His Parish weekend. I was reluctant at first but decided to go. It was a game changer. It enriched my faith, gave me confidence, and was the lightning rod to set me on the path to the priesthood. My dad is a "good and faithful servant."

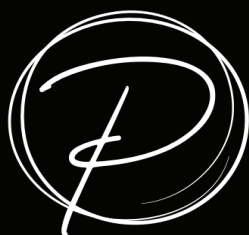
