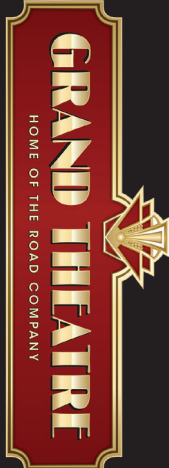

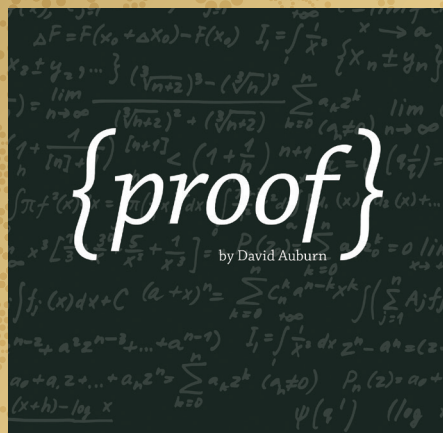


IT'S ONLY A PLAY
