You will need 12 (twelve) – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " assorted strips with longest length being at least 21 inches. You will also need one $12\frac{1}{2} \times 18\frac{1}{2}$ " piece muslin for lining and a piece of batting the same size. Also, you'll need about 75 inches of binding if you choose the quilt-as-you-go method.

Hidden Pocket Hangar Cover – *Linda Albin* 12 to 15 strips of fabrics in various widths and at least 19" long, one 18" or longer zipper, and ½ yd. lightweight muslin and 1 plastic hanger.


