In Latin, there are two words for the "future": *futurum* and *adventus*. Futurum is the future we can project, based on trends and what we have seen before. Adventus, however, is a future that comes to us from beyond ourselves. Adventus is a future open to possibility and filled with anticipation.

For Christians, adventus is a future filled with anticipating an encounter with the Divine. This year, our Advent sermon series anticipates good news through Divine encounters.
