Class will be on backflow assemblies presented by Mr. Bruce Rathburn, Program Director with SAWS. Our training class was on the new 2015 water heater codes; this was some great information for residential users, as to what units are being exempt and to this code and what is not. 20 gallons heaters are exempt, but 30-50 gallon heaters are affected. The energy factor on those units are being increased 2-3 point as is the size of those units by 1 ½ - 2 ½ inches in diameter. Also be aware that the cost will go up also by 30-35 %. This will take affect after April 16, 2015.

Thank you to our vendor who donated door prizes. As always RSVP for the lunches so we will have enough seats and meals for all those that attend. Our next meeting will be on April 22, 2015.



PLEASE NOTE: If you RSVP and do not attend or send a cancellation by 5:00pm the Monday before the luncheon, you could receive a no-show invoice.


SAABE May First Thursday Training Seminar
