

### **Baptism of the Lord**

The Baptism of the Lord is celebrated today, January 9<sup>th</sup>. Jesus was baptized as an adult in the river Jordan by John the Baptist. The story of his baptism is found in three of four Gospels: Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-13, Luke 3:21-22. When Jesus was baptized the heavens opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus in the form of a dove, while a voice from heaven said "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." After Jesus' baptism he was led to the desert where he was tempted for 40 days. Soon we will be in our own desert season as we celebrate Lent!

### **Celebrating Jesus' Baptism**

Our Baptism is such an important day, it is like our birthday! Just as we celebrate our actual birth dates, it is good to remember our baptism "birth" date. This week as a family you can celebrate Jesus' baptism and your own by lighting your baptismal candles (if you still have them) and renewing your baptismal promises. If you don't have your baptismal candle then you can light a white candle to represent it. Have a special meal that night as well, just like you would at a birthday party, to celebrate the importance of our baptism and our call to spread the Gospel as baptized people.
