Over a year ago, a few board members and some of the staff walked up and down Main St. in Waukesha looking for a place to rent for our branch location. We found a large but discreet empty building located a few

doors down from Planned Parenthood. After a couple months of fundraising for the down payment, we had purchased the building. Our next step was to renovate. Thanks to a very generous donors, we were able to build two counseling rooms, a baby boutique, an ultrasound suite, and several work spaces for our staff. The LC staff and several volunteers worked day and night to move furniture in and clean the center. The new coat of paint was barely dry when, after celebrating Mass at St. Mary's in Waukesha, our Director and founder cut the red ribbon to officially open our doors to the center. The next day, three very young women walked in seeking help. Their GPS had taken them right to us when they looked up Planned Parenthood. Not one day after opening were

three young girls' lives changed. We owe this all to the grace of God and your help. Thank you for bringing us to Waukesha to help serve everyone in our community.

We also celebrated our new location with "It's A Wonderful Life Gala" with Father Rocky and Steve "The Homer True" as our guest speaker and auctioneer! A beautiful

Memorial to the Unborn

One of our programs at Life's Connection addresses the needs of the families who suffer from a miscarriage, stillbirth, or newborn loss. Several of our HOPE boxes have been sent out all over the country to bring healing to these grieving families. It was decided that we needed to build memorials in honor of these "little flowers lent, not given, to bud on earth, and bloom in heaven". Many times and for different reasons, after a miscarriage the remains of the child cannot be kept and the parents are left "empty handed" with their grief. This memorial provides a place for parents to go and visit their child they lost and to seek healing and closure. St. Peter's Cemetery has partnered with us in making this a possibility! A beautiful headstone is being made that will be flanked by bricks that have the names of the loved ones etched onto the surface. One woman, who lost her daughter two days after delivery in New York, is grateful that she could have a place to "visit and honor her daughter" here in Wisconsin. This memorial will honor these "little flowers" who, although are not with us today, are never forgotten in the hearts and minds of their family.


