## **DID YOU KNOW?**

#### INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT AIRPLANES:

1. The reason we depart an aircraft on the port side is that the starboard (right) side is where most of the servicing is

done. It is easier and safer to keep the passengers on the opposite side of the airplane from the fuel truck, baggage tugs and carts and catering trucks.

2. The reason the windshield wipers on commercial aircraft are not ripped off in flight at over 500 mpg is that the air flow around the windshield is designed to be less than on the other parts of the airplane. Air flows around the nose and over the top of the windshield, causing an "eddy." This eddy is lower pressure at a lower velocity than the air flowing over the nose.
