

Dubs, Devere

Devere "Simon" Dubs, 92, of Pigeon passed away on Sunday, Jan. 27, 2002 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon. He was born on Oct. 4, 1909, in Winsor Township, the son of the late Louis and Agnes (Proper) Dubs. On April 14, 1934, he married Alma C. Hanke in Detroit. She preceded him in death on Dec. 11, 1996. After his marriage, Mr. Dubs worked in Detroit for the Hudson Motor Co. He then returned to Huron County and farmed full time, as well as working at the sugar factory for a number of harvests. He enjoyed hunting and fishing. He was a member of the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Linkville.
