## LETTER TO THE EDITOR

The recent publication of an Epoch Times opinion piece in our only newspaper is troublesome and should be of concern to us all.

For those who do not know, the Epoch Times is a newspaper in the same way that The National Inquirer is a newspaper. In this case, the Epoch Times is slanted to the far right end of the political spectrum, with two major points of focus...pro-Donald Trump and anti-China.

A claim of stopping censorship is suggesting that the act of censoring news and communication by the government of the US is the same thing as the limiting of news and communication by private, commercial enterprises like Facebook and Twitter. The Constitutional prohibition against censorship and communication is strictly aimed at actions taken by the government against US citizens. If the government stops publication of an article in a newspaper, that is censorship. If that same newspaper controls what it publishes, that is the business of the newspaper and of no Constitutional concern. Facebook is a private company. Twitter is a private company. If it is the case that a private company agrees with what is truth and that concept aligns with the concept held by the government, that is not censorship or collusion. Censorship and collusion must be proven, and this opinion piece does not constitute proof just because it covers half a page in the Journal.

Lori Roman has consistently shown herself to be a proponent of very conservative views, and Naomi Wolfe is more libertarian than liberal, this conclusion based on their past performance and publications. Theirs is not a balanced and even approach to a story.

Reference to emails concerning Dr. Fauci and Facebook founder Mark Zuckerberg do not mention who sent the emails in question, nor does the story tell us whom the e-mails were sent to, nor when, nor who did the redacting. Roman and Wolf are tailoring the material in their story to fit their theme of conspiracy and censorship that is simply not happening at anything beyond what private business ordinarily does. Newspapers routinely decide what stories get printed, and whose letters get published. That does not become censorship until it is proved that the government is doing it, which Roman and Wolf have completely failed to do.

When critical thinking is absent, then the seeds of doubt can take root and grow rumors and distrust. They may choose to give misinformation a pretty name like "inconvenient information" but under that pleasant sounding alias, the ugly creature is still misinformation, and no pretty name can change that.
