DISCUSSION	<p>Discussion concerning the NTSB recommendation reducing the BAC from .08 to .05 nationwide.</p> <p>2010 GCID Wyoming Strategic Plan was accepted by NHTSA and was seen as a model by the review team for other states to emulate. 2014 grant fund requirements – Wyoming is projected to fall into a mid-range category and the plan must be submitted by July 1, 2013. DISCUSSION	Enhanced enforcement initiative is moving forward. A DUI refresher is being conducted on May 20, 2013, with the other (6) counties being scheduled for the training as well. The initiative is being supported with training and media support with a good network of media coordinators across the state. Media funds will be re-allocated to provide additional media support and reducing the funds allocated to enforcement. The enforcement piece is being funded through agencies regular Highway Safety Grants.	
	The Lifesavers conference had several workshops on social media and how we can enhance our efforts through some of the social media outlets. Brandon Emmert built a facebook page for WASCOP and has done a trial page for the council. To increase and build awareness the page could be maintained by a daily post dealing with news, police, local and national news. With a strong filter the information can be monitored for content. Ernie suggested that if the project was to move forward that the council needed to provide their support for the concept and monetary cost. 1 hour a day to research and post information. Brandon suggested a fee of \$250 per month for the first three months with an evaluation of the project by the council at the August meeting.
