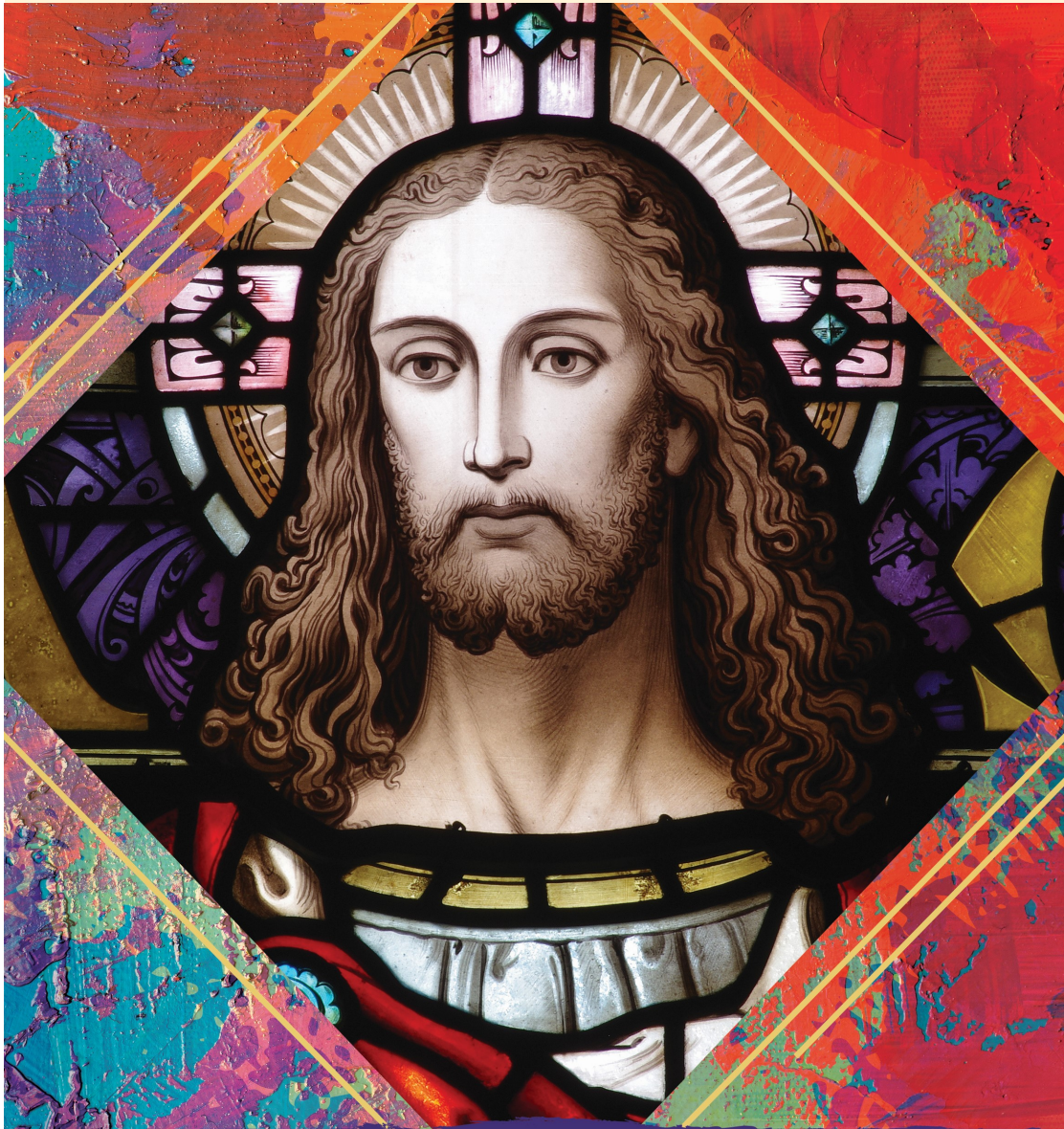

St. Pius X Feast Day- August 21st

Facts about our Parish Patron:

- He was born in Italy and his name was Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto.
- He was very Devoted to Our Blessed Mother.
- He loved children, and would often give out candy to child he saw on his walks and try to teach them about our Faith.
- He mandated CCD in Parishes. At the time it was a common belief that it was inappropriate for children to be taught about God and the Church, Pope Pius X required churches to teach 'Sunday School' that is; Catechesis to Children!
- He was a member of the Third Order of Saint Francis.
- After the 1908 Messina earthquake he filled the Apostolic Palace with refugees, showing his compassion to those in poverty and in need.
- "Holy Communion is the shortest and safest way to Heaven." - Pope St. Pius X
- He encouraged frequent reception of Holy Communion, also extending the reception to children who had reached the "age of discretion," later to be the age of reason.
- Pius XII referred to Pius X as "Pope of the Eucharist" also "Pope of the Blessed Sacrament", in honor of Pius X's expansion of the rite to children.

"Perpetual Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament is the devotion which surpasses all others."

"The daily adoration or visit to the Blessed Sacrament is the practice which is the fountainhead of all devotional works."

"Devotion to the Eucharist is the most noble, because it has God as its object; it is the most profitable for salvation, because it gives us the Author of Grace; it is the sweetest, because the Lord is Sweetness Itself."
