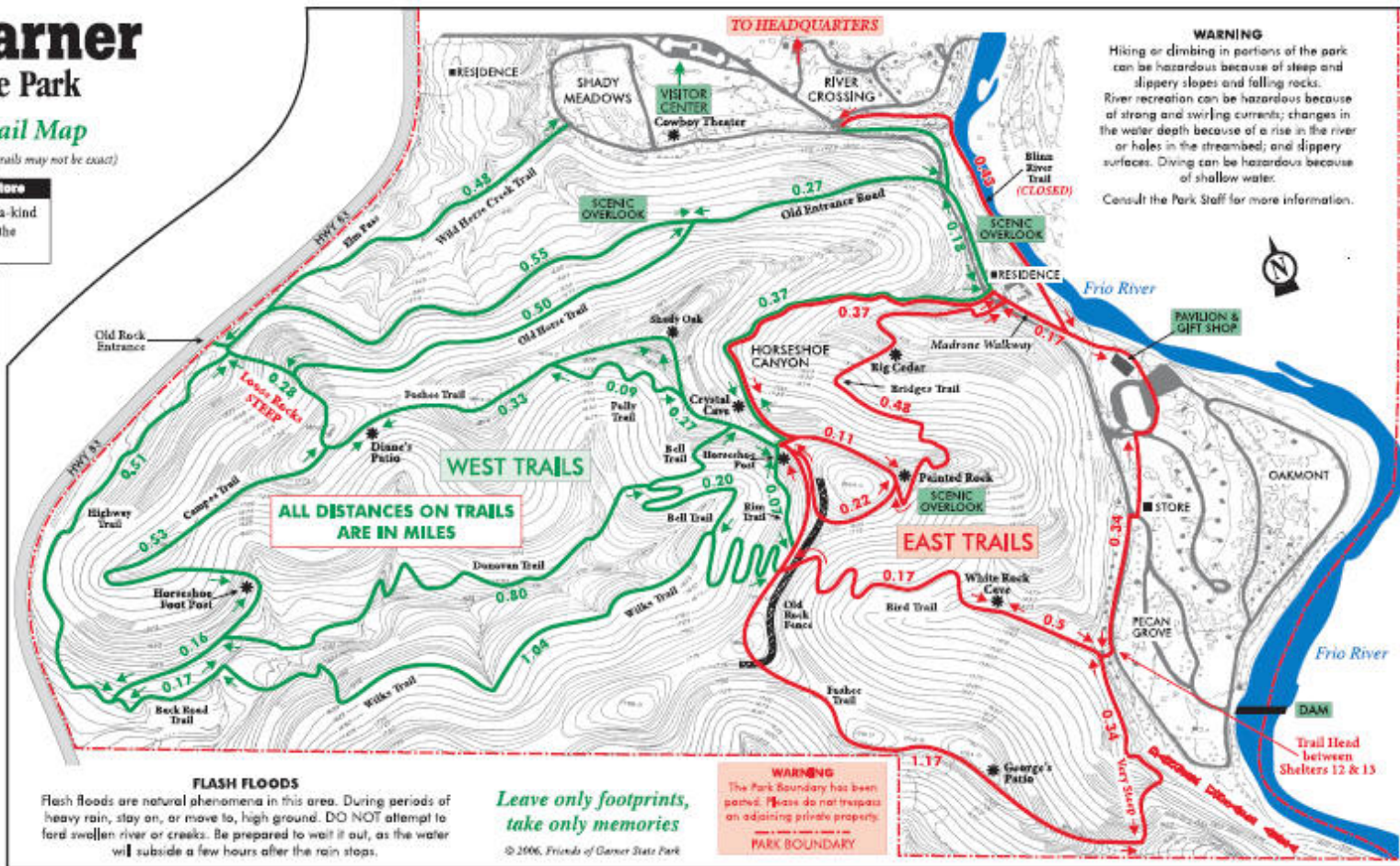

Hiking or climbing in portions of the park can be hazardous because of steep and slippery slopes and falling rocks. River recreation can be hazardous because of strong and swirling currents; changes in the water depth because of a rise in the river or holes in the streambed; and slippery surfaces. Diving can be hazardous because of shallow water. Consult the Park Staff for more information.

**FLASH FLOODS**  
Flash floods are natural phenomena in this area. During periods of heavy rain, stay on, or move to, high ground. DO NOT attempt to ford swollen river or creeks. Be prepared to wait it out, as the water will subside a few hours after the rain stops.
