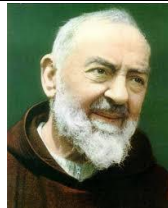

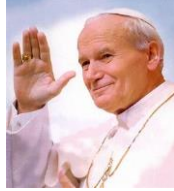


HOLY SPIRIT
