

Teen Sewing Supply List

Please NO sewing machines the first 2 days of class. There should be time to address questions on particular models another day.

- 3/4 yard of cotton for the main part of the pillowcase
- 1/2 yard of complimentary cotton for the pillowcase opening
- 1/4 yard of accent fabric for the pillowcase

- 1/2 yard of cotton or other non-stretchy, non-shiny fabric for the tote bag (not too thick! Multiple layers are sewn & it can get very bulky)
- 2 yards 1/2" wide grosgrain ribbon, or another type of similarly-sized string/strapping for the backpack straps

- 2 1/2 yards of 45" wide cotton or flannel fabric for the pj pants (1 1/2 for shorts)
OR
1 1/2 yards of 60" wide cotton or flannel fabric for the pj pants (1 yd for shorts)
- Enough 3/4" elastic to go around your waist (un-stretched)

- 1 spool of all-purpose polyester thread that matches the main color of your biggest piece of fabric (the unused portion will go into the thread-pool for the class & you can take other colors you need from the existing thread-pool)

- We recommend pre-washing & drying all your fabrics.**

Provided items:

- ✓ PJ pants pattern
- ✓ Appliqué materials (if used)
- ✓ Use of sewing equipment

The following items are not required, as the sewing classroom is well-equipped, but you may choose to have your own:

- Small see-through ruler (approx 2"x18" and flexible)
- Scissors
- Glass or metal head Pins & Pin cushion
- Seam ripper
- Hand sewing needles
- Bees' wax or Thread Heaven
- Tape Measure
- Thread clippers
- Magnifier glasses
- Supply bin/tote
- Hem gauge
- Tailor's chalk or other marking tool(s)

If you do bring supplies, please mark them with your name or a distinctive ribbon.
