Today's Gospel begins the "Bread ↓ of Life" discourse that will continue over the next few Sundays. In the dialogue that takes place between Jesus and the crowd who have gathered around him, Jesus urges his listeners to look beyond earthly things and to see that the feeding of the multitudes (from last week's Gospel)



was a sign pointing to the spiritual nourishment that the Son of Man is offering - "the true bread from heaven that gives life to the world". Thus, Jesus begins to lead the people to Eucharistic faith. Jesus declares that if they believe – if they have the faith that is able to recognize what God is offering them - he will be their nourishment for eternal life. As disciples of Jesus, we too are called to look beyond the forms of bread and wine and to see with the eyes of faith that, each time we receive Holy Communion, we are receiving the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus, the true food that endures for eternal life.

The account of the Transfiguration is an aweinspiring indication of the resplendent glory that belongs to Jesus as God's unique Son. However, following histransfiguration, Jesus moves steadily toward his death. Thus, we must not lose sight of the broader message: Whoever follows Jesus must be willing to do what he did and so renounce glory in exchange for suffering.
