### 2021 Property Tax Pre-payments

Pre-payments can be made based on your 2020 taxes and can be paid monthly at any amount, as even partial payments receive the discounted rates.

**5% discount** for payments in Jan, Feb, or Mar

**3% discount** for payments in Apr, May or Jun

**1% discount** for payments in Jul or Aug

*Payment Options:*

1. Online (internet banking or e-transfer)
2. In person (debit, cash or cheque.)
3. If available, set up direct payment with your financial institution.

## Landfill FAQ's

- Tickets for the landfill must be purchased at Town Office. Tickets are not available at the Landfill.
- Carload \$5; Utility Trailer \$10; Truck \$15
- Furniture and Appliances: \$5 per item
- Refrigeration Appliances: \$5 per item and a Certificate verifying the removal of the refrigerant
- No hazardous materials accepted
- Grass, leaves and branches are free
- Shingle disposal fee = \$5.60 per approx. bundle
